



Eight New Rooms Including Flagship Suite Signal Summer at Santorini Grace

20 July 09: [Grace Hotels](#) unveils what it believes is the largest hotel suite on Santorini's Caldera and a further seven new rooms at the [Santorini Grace](#) luxury boutique hotel - just in time for the summer peak season. A new infinity pool with stunning aerial views has also been added. This sister hotel to the award winning Mykonos Grace, now comprises a total of 17 distinguished rooms including the exquisite Grace Suite which the company says is the finest and most indulgent suite on Santorini.

Offering guests the hotel's most luxurious accommodation, the newly opened Grace Suite comprises living space of 155sqm in its full, two-bedroom configuration. It has two outdoor plunge pools, an indoor Jacuzzi, private Hamman steam bath, double shower and panoramic views over the Caldera that will take your breath away.



The understated, elegant décor, that has become synonymous with Grace Hotels, immediately eases guests of the Grace Suite into a tranquil Greek island life. Meanwhile the suite's private terrace is the perfect spot to enjoy a Grace cocktail at sundown, a romantic champagne breakfast or a cooling dip in one of the private plunge pools during the heat of the day.

Along with the Grace Suite, the Santorini Grace's additions this summer include seven new rooms ranging from Deluxe Rooms and Junior Suites to the 'Skaros' Suite and a VIP Suite. Another feature incorporated into selected rooms is a unique 'one-way' window treatment. Fragments of volcanic rock are positioned in the window spaces and interspersed with gaps that provide glimpses to the azure sea beyond. This pioneering creation by architects Memos Filippides and Nikolas Travasaros of Athens-based practices MplusM & Divercity allows privacy and ventilation and casts extraordinary speckled light patterns on the floors as the sun goes down.

Expertly crafted into the steep hillside, the Santorini Grace boasts magical sunsets, attentive team members and simple, elegant luxury. Situated 300m above the Caldera; a deep basin formed in

1500BC from a collapsed volcano, the hotel overlooks the Aegean, the islands of Thirasia, Palaia and Nea Kameni and impressive Venetian castle ruins on Skaros Rock.

The Grace Suite at Santorini Grace is available from €725 per night and includes champagne breakfast, transfers to and from the hotel and all taxes. Other rooms start at €250.
