Best by boat

Grace Santorini, Greece

As vantage points go, this Greek island classic is hard to beat. Perched on a sheer lava cliff overlooking the island's crater-like caldera, the white-on-white hotel has just renovated its 21 rooms and suites; or ask for the 400m² double suite, the Villa. There is also a new Champagne lounge, with terraces affording a bird's-eye view of Santorini's famous sunsets. Yachts can berth on a floating dock in the old port, five minutes' drive from the hotel, while larger vessels should head to Vlychada marina, 25 to 30 minutes' drive away. Come in May to drink in the views (and the Champagne) before the crowds descend. gracehotels.com/santorini
